- 7. **DON'T** send your partner in for help. We want him to live, too.
- 8. **DON'T** start walking back under any conditions unless you are POSITIVE you can make it back to civilization. We know from past experience that even a man who is sure of his surroundings seldom gets back alive.
- DON'T get excited or panicky in your desolation. It makes the heat less bearable and the chances are good that we will find you.
- 10. **DON'T** take any chances. The desert is treacherous and can fool you.
- 11. **DON'T** forget We will be searching for you and your patience is your best virtue.
- **12. DON'T** forget all these things and your chances of surviving in the desert are 99 percent better than if you paid no heed to them.
